Music for Youth presentation: Rick Sadlon and Tammy Sload gave a brief overview of Music for Youth, a 501(c)(3) that works in partnership with DPS staff to provide enrichment that is aligned with the curriculum. Some of the work they do includes: bringing in performance groups at the elementary level, running master classes at the secondary level, sponsoring grade appropriate contests with prizes, and awarding scholarships to rising DHS seniors. This year's focus is around jazz and events are planned similar to those above. Fundraising continues to be a challenge. In addition to yearly donations from each school, Music for Youth relies on individual donations. Flyers will be distributed in January to solicit individual donations. Music for Youth is requesting the same donation as last year (\$350) from all PTOs.
